Dear Parents and Carers,

BBC News last week featured the tragic story of teacher, Helen Daykin. In October 2016, Helen was working away from home when her husband, Chris, died suddenly whilst looking after their young children. After his sudden death from heart failure in the house, Helen's little girls, four and two, spent almost 24 hours with the body of their father.

The older girl had recently started school, and when she didn't arrive, the school rang their father, to no avail. Tragically, they didn't then follow up with a call to the girls' mother, 200 miles away in London.

Although an extreme example, we frequently are unable to contact some parents on the first day of absence. All schools have been asked to review their First Day Call Procedures to make sure they are robust enough. I thought I would share with you the procedures we will now follow since this sad event.

## First Day Call Procedure

- Get registers in promptly
- Listen to absence calls, read absence emails
- Bring together registers, lates, absence calls - produce the list of children absent with no explanation
- Start first day calling for children absent without explanation, call everyone on the contact list until you get an answer. Leave messages if there is a voicemail option.
- You might get an overseas ring tone - is the family taking a holiday they haven't told you about?
- Call the contact list at least twice
- If no reply at all consider whether any children have additional agency support, such as a social worker, contact them.
- Do you have any in school intelligence, does anyone know the family.
- No explanation from a supportive family is very worrying - so don't just concentrate on children who you already know to be vulnerable.
- Make a prompt home visit.
- If you cannot get an answer refer immediately to children's services / MASH / Police and request a welfare call.

(If you can see them inside a house avoiding your knock, don't refer - unless you think the children are at risk of significant harm)

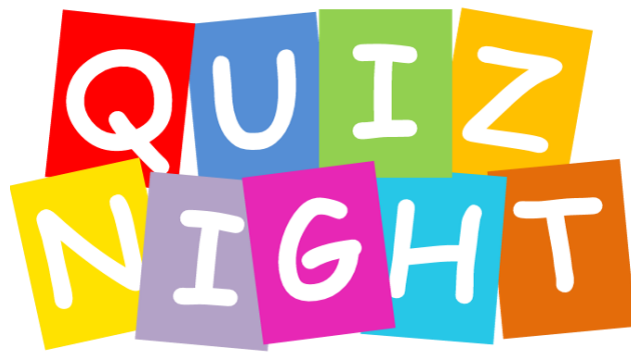
