Our Friends are again collecting via Bag2School. Bags are going home this week and will be collected on 5th March.

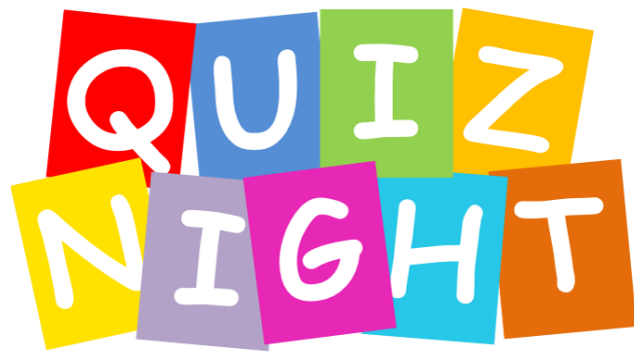
