Dear Parents and Carers,

Whole School Sports Afternoon

Friday 25th May

Once again, we are going to make our sports day a big family event by inviting parents to come to school and bring a picnic lunch to share with their children.

Reception and KS1 Children are entitled to a free school lunch. If you would like us to provide a school picnic bap for your Reception/KS1 child please book one on the reply slip at the end of the newsletter indicating their choice of bap filling or alternatively indicate that you will be bringing a picnic from home.

KS2 children may pre order the individual school picnic bap at the usual cost of £2.30. They will get a delicious bap containing a choice of filling: cheese, ham or tuna; served together with vegetable sticks, fruit, a drink and a cookie.

Please would all parents return the reply slip at the end of the newsletter by Friday 18th May indicating if you will be bringing a picnic or ordering your child a school picnic bap. Please do ensure this slip is returned as we do need to hear from every parent. Thank you.

Parents are welcome to arrive anytime between midday and 12.30pm. You can bring your rugs and chairs if you would like to. Children will have a short play in the school playground before joining parents at 12.30pm for approximately 20 minutes to eat their picnic lunch. Any children whose parents cannot come to the sports afternoon will sit with friends or staff and they can of course bring in a packed lunch from home if they wish. Children will then go back to class to register and prepare for the races.

After lunch the sports will start with KS1 races and then KS2 races at approximately 1.45pm. When the KS1 children have finished their races they can stay with their parents but please note that they must be supervised at all times and the Adventure Playground equipment will be out of bounds. They will not be able to leave the school premises until all Key Stages have completed their races.

Should the weather forecast be inclement we will aim to make a decision the day before re any necessary postponement.
